1. WHERE WE CAN WORK

- ☐ **Home driveways** Level asphalt or concrete. Legal, level street parking out of moving traffic also works.
- ☐ **Workplace & office lots** Employee or visitor lots where property management permits on-site automotive service.
- ☐ **Business lots, fleet yards, job sites** Level, stable ground away from traffic and equipment movement.
- ☐ **Apartment & condo lots** Possible with property approval. Confirm with management before booking.
- ☐ **Parking garages** Case by case: overhead clearance, ventilation, level deck and garage permission.

2. WHAT STOPS A JOB - WE WILL NOT START OR WILL STOP SERVICE WHEN:

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| ☐ The vehicle is in an active traffic lane | ☐ The vehicle cannot be accessed safely |
| ☐ The ground is dangerously sloped or the surface is unstable | ☐ Environmental conditions make service unsafe |
| ☐ There is insufficient clearance to work safely | ☐ Vehicle size or weight exceeds our available equipment |
| ☐ Property management prohibits automotive service on site | |

If we arrive and the location is not safe or not permitted, we do not force the appointment. We explain what we are seeing, look for a nearby spot that does work, and reschedule at no charge if there is no safe option. You are never charged for a visit we cannot perform safely.

3. HOW TO PREPARE THE LOCATION

- ☐ Park on the most level, solid surface available - concrete or asphalt over gravel, dirt or grass.
- ☐ Leave roughly one open parking space beside and in front of the vehicle so equipment fits.
- ☐ Get property or management approval in advance at a workplace, apartment, condo or garage.
- ☐ Let the engine cool when you can. A vehicle parked at least 30 minutes is safer and cleaner to service.
- ☐ Leave the vehicle unlocked or plan to meet us, and make the keys available for the level check and reset.
- ☐ Clear the area of bikes, toys, trash bins, pets and children before the appointment window.
- ☐ Tell us in advance about low clearance, skid plates, lift kits, oversized tires or a tight access path.
- ☐ Share gate codes, badge requirements, lot entrances and after-hours access details when they apply.
